Any woman of the age of 18 years old or older may apply to the Association for a membership as a General Member and upon acceptance by the board and contribution of the appropriate membership dues, if any, shall be admitted as a member.

A Member shall commence to be a member in good standing 30 days after the admission as a member in accordance with these bylaws. She shall cease to be in good standing if the Association has not received her contribution of current annual membership dues by the due date. Annual Membership dues are due on the day before beginning of the member's current membership year. Any member who is not in good standing on the date notice of a general meeting is given shall not be in good standing at the meeting.
